

The Clinical Pastoral Education program at Phoebe Ministries is designed to offer students opportunities to practice ministry in a variety of settings. The clinical setting is a primary learning resource for Clinical Pastoral Education students. At York Hospital, we provide most available clinical services except organ transplantation. York Hospital is a modern 572-bed community teaching hospital that employs more than 4,400 people and serves a population of 520,000 + in south central Pennsylvania. York Hospital is a Level 1 Trauma Center and a Primary Stroke Center. The clinical opportunities for ministry in this setting are vast and varied. The CPE program includes a curriculum of five seminars (verbatim, didactic, interpersonal group, integration and individual supervision). Each unit is made up of 100 hours of supervised education and 300 hours of clinical ministry. Students are assigned to a Service Line for the duration of their training program.
